Late Sri Ch. Narahari, Forest Beat Officer was born on 26-1-1959 in Eligedu (V) of Julapally Mandal, Karimnagar District. He was appointed as Forest Beat Officer on 5-11-1990 in Karimnagar West Division. Further on he performed his duties in capacity of Forest Beat Officer in Mobile Party, Jagtial, Chinthaloor and Bornapally of Raikal Range and further on he was deputed to work in Flying Squad Party, Karimnagar.

While performing his duties in the Flying Squad Division, Karimnagar on Ugadi Festival day during night patrolling along with other party members have seized a lorry loaded with illegal teak timber at Metpally of Raikal Range. The smugglers attacked the party with swords when the other party members flee from the scene, Late Sri Ch. Narahari, Forest Beat Officer single handedly and daringly opposed and tried to apprehend the smugglers and vehicles, during which he was injured with the sword in his belly and eventually killed on the spot on 29-3-1998. His valuable and courageous services are fondly remembered. He is survived by his wife and two sons.

His wife Smt. Ch. Pushpalatha has been provided job under compassionate grounds as Attender and since then has been working in

Karimnagar West Division till date. His pension-cum-death benefits were settled.
