Sub:- Forests - Make India Green Campaign - Raising of seedlings during 1980-81 for the supply in 1981 season - Instructions issued.

Ref:- G.O.Ms.No.358, Forest & Rural Dev.(For.I) Department dated 9.7.1980.

In the G.O. read above, the Government accorded sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 9,05,000/- during 80-81 for raising seedlings of trees and purchase of coconut seedlings for implementing the Make India Green Schemes in 14 districts. In other districts which are covered by D.P.A.P., the seedlings are to be raised utilising D.P.A.P. funds.

The seedlings raised during 1979-80 were all distributed in the rains of 1980, mostly to farmers, for blocks or field bund planting, to public and various institutions like schools, industrial units etc., for planting in house compounds and other vacant lands. There have been however a number of cases this year where the Divl.Forest Officers were not able to meet the full demand for supply of seedlings of required species by individuals and institutions which together required large numbers of seedlings of different species for planting. In order that the department, (Different Divl.Forest Officers) are not caught on the wrong foot atleast in the years to come, and to ensure that in all divisions adequate number of seedlings of different species are raised every year, to meet the likely demand for next years planting in full, without however leaving large number of seedlings as surplus and unutilised, it is proposed to take necessary action to assess the demand for seedlings of different species in different divisions during 1981 from individual farmers, public, schools and other institutions which obtain seedlings from the Department.

In order to achieve this all Conservator of Forests are requested to issue further detailed instructions if necessary immediately to all their Divl.Forest Officers to give wide publicity through local A.I.R. Stations, News Papers and other media, requesting farmers and other public, schools, Panchayats, Municipalities and all other institutions and industrial establishment who require more than 100 seedlings of all species put together for planting during 1981 season, to register at once, and in any case more than end of November'80, their requirements with the concerned Divl.Forest Officers to enable each Divl.Forest Officer to assess the total number of seedlings

of different species that need be raised in each division
entitled to receive seeds or saplings for 1901 planting.

The Govt. is giving lists and specific and detailed information
on the number of saplings required for the
various Forest Department (in each division) in future to supply more
than 50 individuals or institutions or persons than 100 seedlings
to the extent of 10% above the requirement
up to 1901 and so in advance, i.e. during November, December,
and January, with the concerned Divl. Forest Office. In addition to
the above acreage here or total number of seedlings required as per
specifications by Public and Forest Department, each
Division of Forest, will have about 2500 seedlings of
different species for unclassified cases and individuals and
institutions which require seedlings in smaller numbers, keeping
in view the total intake in each division annually so far.

The stock is kept in view of the same as Table A1
but the form of proforma in English prepared in this office for
registration by firms etc., is unclear. Similar proforma may
be distributed elsewhere giving due publicity through news
papers, pamphlets and other media. Applications received by each
Divl. Forest Office should be registered and recorded in a Special
register so to be checked by the nursery, registering names of
individuals or institutions separately launched Sanithi wise and
each individual institution informed of the receipt of their
application and the nursery from which the seedlings will be
supplied in rains of 1901.

The receipt of this reference may be acknowledged
and action taken in this regard may please be intimated to this
office in due course.

Some time ago the procedure will be followed every year in future
also. It is being instructed now to establish a working-plan
for the year 1901 and serviceable for the period
beginning January 1st to December 31st for the following year

which will be issued to the concerned Divl. Forest Office
and the Director of Forests (D.F.P.)

DEPARTMENT TEST - SHORT NOTES

THE CONTROL BOOK:- This record shall ordinarily be maintained for each
working circle and shall be written up annually. The objects of the
control books are -

- a) to compare the actual exploitation of the year (such as felling, girding, extraction of minor produce and grazing) with the prescriptions of the working-plan;
- b) to record the yield of timber and other produce and the revenue derived therefrom;
- c) in the event of the area or quantity of material exploited in any year being less than that prescribed in the working-plan, to provide for the bringing forward year by year of the balance still available for exploitation, until it is exploited or written off under competent authority;
- d) in the event of any exploitation in excess (whether of material or area) of the prescriptions of the plan, to provide that such excess shall, unless orders to the contrary are issued by competent authority be deducted from
