

But instances have come to notice that the enclosure boundaries have been encroached on the plex of lack of clear cut boundary demarcation in certain blocks and the Department has been finding it difficult to check these encroachments without resorting to litigation. A recent case has come to notice where a Forest Department had encroached on 35 acres of Forest land which led to legal complications under the Forest Conservation Act.

Therefore all the Divisional Forest Officers are requested to see that all the boundaries of the enclosures in each forest block of their division are verified with the admitted maps and red and maintained with clear cut ~~marks~~ corners on a priority basis based on the original notifications. This work should be completed within 2 months from the date of receipt of this circular. It is also suggested that all points of issues like Roads, paths etc. clear cut sign Boards be put up informing the P.F. etc.,

The Conservators of Forests are requested to make it a point to inspect these boundaries during their tours in the division and satisfy themselves about the state of these enclosure boundaries. The Conservators of Forests are requested to initiate drastic action against any lapses noticed in their tours.

Sub:- B.L. Sales in Andhra Region Not fetching good rates due to lack of competition certain instructions to the DFC's Issued... Regarding.

It is brought to the notice of the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests that the needful units which

are sold in open auction in Andhra Region, are not fetching good rates as the beedi leaves traders/Exporters/Manufacturers, registered under Andhra Pradesh Forest Minor Forest Produce Regulation of Trade Act, 1971 were not informed well in advance of the sale dates of beedi leaves. As a result, due to lack of competition at sale places, the beedi leaf is being sold at cheaper rates and the contractors who have purchased this material at cheaper rates in the auctions, are re-selling the material at lower rates compared to the rates sold by the Registered traders/Exporters/Manufacturers under Minor Forest Produce (beedi Leaf) Act, effecting the sale of the registered traders.

All the Divisional Forest Officers of Andhra Region are requested to send the sale notices to the contractors whose addresses are enclosed to this circular well in advance so as to reach them at least 15 days before the sale date. They are also requested to submit 10 copies of sale notice to the Conservator of Forests, State Trading Circle, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad so that few copies may be sent to the Beedi Leaves contractors association also.
